# **TOP TIPS FOR DOING AN ACTION PROJECT:**

#### **Five Steps to a Cleaner, Brighter Future**

- **Gather a team** this can be your class, your green school committee, or a mix of students, teachers & people from the community.
- **Research** take a look at our website to learn more about the benefits of solar on schools and the barriers today.
- **Brainstorm** once you've learned about the benefits of solar energy, the barriers that exist and the solutions grab your team and start brainstorming!
- Action points once you've decided on your idea set some clear action points and decide who's responsible. Think of all the people you need to get on board e.g. teachers, parents, politicians etc. Create a timeline with realistic deadlines.
  - Raise Awareness Don't forget to raise awareness of your project. Host an event, start a social media campaign, write a press release? Remember our hashtags are #ForTheLoveOfSolar #SolarSchools #generationsolar

- Is your project related to community energy/renewable energy/ solar energy/climate change?
- Does your project have an awareness-raising element?
- Will your project improve your team working skills?

- Does your project include other people in your school (teacher, students, parents, Board members)?

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- Does your project engage other members of the community (local people, local newspapers, clubs, politicians, TDs etc.)?
- Does your project demonstrate your knowledge of environmental issues, particularly knowledge relating to energy, climate change, environmental policies in Ireland & Europe?

#### Support to carry out your action project.

st The final number of winning schools is dependent on the level of grant that will be available from the Sustainable Energy Authority of Ireland, and so it could increase from 8 to 16 winners. 2020 will be the first year schools can avail of grants for solar panels. Details of the scheme are expected before end 2109.

**Solar on Schools is a great idea but it's very difficult for schools to do it!** This year we are helping 8 schools to go solar (potential for up to 16 winners\*) but we would like to see every school become a Solar School by 2025!

# ACT NOW! WE ARE ASKING THE GOVERNMENT TO MAKE IT EASIER FOR SCHOOLS TO GO SOLAR BY:

Providing grants to schools & community buildings for solar panels.

- 2 Allowing Solar Schools (and all community buildings) to sell any extra power they generate but don't use – right now (without a special partnership) schools would be giving it into the grid for free!
- Changing the planning rules. Unlike other community buildings, schools have to apply for planning permission for even one solar panel! This is a huge additional cost.
