

Social Media Community Guidelines Policy

Friends of the Earth's Social Media Community Guidelines Policy sets out how we expect all users to engage, interact and communicate on Friends of the Earth's social media channels

To help create a safe, constructive environment on our social media channels we have set out some guidelines which apply to any engagement with us or other members of the Friends of the Earth community on any of our social media channels.

By engaging with our social media channels you agree to follow these guidelines.

Comments must not:

- Include hate speech, including (but not limited to) comments that are racist, homophobic, transphobic or misogynistic.
- Include offensive, inappropriate or obscene language or content (including images, videos or links).
- Include threatening, violent, abusive or insulting statements likely to stir up hatred.
- Include personal attacks or name calling aimed at Friends of the Earth staff, community members, volunteers or other members of the public.
- Include material which is defamatory of any person.
- Include material breaching the data protection, privacy or confidentiality rights of any person.
- Promote discrimination based on ethnic or social origin, sex, religion, nationality, disability, sexual orientation, age.
- Include spam messages or spam material, such as the same commenter commenting or asking the same questions repeatedly.

Include false, misleading or deceptive statements, including, but not limited to, climate misinformation and disinformation.

- Include content that is off topic or repetitive.

Friends of the Earth reserves the right to hide or delete comments made on our channels, as well as block any user of the Friends of the Earth social media channels that breaches the above requirements.
