We work closely and flexibly as a team to advance the organization's goals, values and mission. This means there'll be plenty of opportunities to learn and develop new skills. It also means you'll need to be flexible and you'll be expected to get stuck in and do whatever tasks are required to ensure that work is completed on time.

Our internship programme is named in honour of Ciarán King, a generous and committed supporter who died in 2010.

The Position

As Communications and Supporter Relations Intern you will

- Prepare and post material on our website and social media.
- Handle queries from supporters and members of the public.
- Play an important role in maintaining our supporter database, and supporting our migration to a new database / CRM* package.
- Assist with supporter relations administration.
- Support the communications-related work of the Director, the Campaigns Manager and the Supporter Relations Manager.
- Assist the Supporter Relations Manager in the recruitment of new supporters and development of existing supporters, carried out in house or by outside agencies.
- Participate as a full member of staff in organizational activities and meetings.

The Nitty Gritty
